

GUITAR NOTES


⊕ Bars 31–32 and 107: Signifies that the string should be taken between thumb and first finger, lifted higher than normal, and made to rebound onto the fret board.



Bars 35–40 and 90: The right hand is to strike the sound box below the bridge after the style of a drum.



Bars 41 and 91: Fingers 3,2 and 1 of the left hand should glissando up and past the last fret as far as possible, while the right hand maintains a rasgueado on all six strings.



Bar 51: 'Biting tasto'. This passage to be played 'sul tasto' but with a harsher attack, giving a metallic tone not unlike 'sul ponticello'.
